Welcome to Cascade Christian Schools!

Frederickson is 1 of 6 campuses serving South Pierce County. Our campus serves students 3-years-old through 6th grade and provides services for students year-round from 6:00 AM – 6:00 PM. Besides elementary school, we offer traditional preschool, childcare, and extended school (before and after school care and activities).

BEFORE SCHOOL:

- Please park in the designated parking lot and walk your student(s) to class for grades K-2nd. Students in 3-6th grade may be dropped off through our drive-up option.
- All students should use the restroom BEFORE entering their classrooms.
- Teachers are prepared to receive students at 9:15AM on Mondays and 8:15 AM Tuesday-Friday. Students need to be checked in to Cougar Club if on campus prior to classroom doors opening.
- School starts and classroom doors will close PROMPTLY at **9:30AM (Mon) and 8:30AM (TUE-FRI)**. Any parents still on campus when classroom doors close need to check-in at the office.
- Students are TARDY if they are not in their classrooms, ready to learn, by 9:30AM/8:30 AM. Classroom doors are then locked and all students arriving after this must be checked in at the office by their parent/guardian.

DURING SCHOOL:

- To ensure safety, all parents and volunteers must ALWAYS sign-in at the front office and wear their visitor's badge.
- Volunteers must complete appropriate background checks prior to volunteering on campus.
- Please pre-arrange all classroom visits with classroom teachers.
- Students leaving school before dismissal MUST be signed out in the school office.
- Recess times vary throughout the day.
- Snack times vary, but healthy snacks are highly encouraged.
- Lunch takes place in the classroom and is accompanied by a 30-minute recess.
- Hot lunch options are available and paid for through your FACTS account.
- Chapels are on Wednesdays from 9:30-10:00AM in the auditorium. The last Wednesday of the month the students will participate in Cougar Family Groups which takes place throughout the campus in the form of small groups.
- All School Openings (ASO) are Mondays 9:45-10:00AM.
- All students have the opportunity to enjoy Music, Computers/Library, and PE each week in addition to their homeroom classes. Sixth grade will participate in band in lieu of music.
- Medication forms are available in the office.

AFTER SCHOOL:

- Park and pick your student(s) up at their classroom (all grade levels).
- The teacher will open the classroom door. Please wait patiently outside the classroom door for your student. All adults picking up students must have ID and be on the check-out list.
- To add a family member or friend who is authorized to pick-up your child, please come to the office to add those individual(s).
- Students will be released from their classroom at 3:15 PM.
- Students not picked up by 3:30 PM will be taken to Cougar Club which will incur a fee.

Safety and Security

- Our campus is equipped with security cameras
- The school office has a buzz-in system for entry
- Doors are locked throughout the day
- Staff is trained on emergency procedures
- We participate in monthly drills as a campus

- Don't forget your child's emergency kit
- Buddy system for 3-6 students during the day
- Teachers are provided with pick-up lists; changes to pick-up lists are done in the school office
- An armed VSO security guard is on campus during regular school hours

During the School Day

- Students may not be on campus before/after classroom doors open without adult supervision
- Late arriving students (9:30M/8:30T-F) need to be checked in at the office and will be reported as tardy
- On-time attendance is essential to your child's success and that of their peers.
- Absences can be reported through SchoolStatus
- Please let the classroom teacher know of upcoming vacations or planned absences at least two weeks prior
- Parents may check their child out at the office during the day
- Once parents are present, students will be sent to the office for pick-up
- During winter months, classroom doors will be kept closed to conserve heat
- Please write your child's name on all sweaters, jackets and water bottles so we can successfully return them to your child.

Dress Code

- Refer to Parent/Student Handbook for specific details
- Comfortable and modest
- Tennis shoes for PE days
- Shorts under skirts and dresses for recess play
- Save make-up and colored hair for junior high
- Leggings must be covered by a longer top
- Legs must be covered starting October 1st

Medications

- For any student needing medication administered: parent MUST pick up an ICP (individual care plan) form for your child's doctor to sign with the medication and doses listed
- Medications must come to school in the original prescription containers with doctor's name and expiration date on it

Snacks/Lunch

- It is essential that your child consumes healthy snacks and drinks at school.
- Students will communicate if they have a lunch from home or need a hot lunch when they enter the classroom each day
- FACTS is used to pay for hot lunches, and balances need to be kept current
- No lunches on half-days

Electronics



Volunteering

- All volunteers must go through a CCS background check.
- Classroom volunteering opportunities will be available directly through the classroom teacher
- Volunteers must sign in/out at school office and wear the appropriate volunteer badge.
