

League Philosophy, Expectations, Rules

League Rules / Guidelines

- Fuel League is currently available for 3rd-6th grade boys/girls. (3rd/4th) (5th/6th Divisions)
- Competitive / Recreational divisions will be created for each age division.
- No Co-Ed teams will be allowed.

Conduct Expectations

- Coaches and players remain seated unless a coach is standing up to give instruction or requesting a time out.
- Coaches must remain in their coaching box.
- Coaches or players may not disrespectfully address an official at any time.
- Coaches or players, or spectators may not use profane or inappropriate language or obscene gestures at any time.
- Coaches, player, or spectators may not disrespectfully bait or taunt an opponent.
- The head coach is responsible for the conduct and behavior of the players, assistant coaches, and spectators from your team.
- Coaches, players, and spectators may not confront officials before, during, or after a game.
- Any coach, player, or spectator who fails to comply with the above rules will be subject to technical fouls, ejection, or suspension depending on the severity of the violation.

Reminder to Coaches

1. If you want your team to come early to stretch, please instruct your team to meet in the foyer/hallway of the gym to do this. Often, teams will only get 5-7 minutes of warm-up so be stretched out and ready to take the court!
2. In information that you sent home, please remind parents that small children are not allowed to run unattended at game and water bottles and garbage should be picked up after games.
