Cascade Christian Schools Kindergarten Entrance Process for new students

What Are the Basic Requirements for Kindergarten?

- The student must be five years old before September 1.
- All new students will be assessed for kindergarten readiness in the following areas:

• Social-emotional

• Cognitive

• Physical

Literacy

• Language

Mathematics

How Is Developmental Readiness Assessed?

- Once a new student application is received, parents will be contacted to set up an assessment appointment with the school.
- A trained assessor uses Readiness Assessment Tools to assess
 the child's developmental maturity by comparing the child's
 results with a national norming study of children of the same
 age, in the key developmental areas.

How Do We Enroll for Kindergarten at CCS?

- 1. If you haven't already, schedule a tour at your preferred campus.
- 2. Fill out the application and pay the application fee online. Submit all application forms.
- 3. Office personnel will reach out to you to schedule an independent assessment for your student.
- 4. Parents attend an interview with campus principal. You will be able to discuss the results of your child's assessment at this time.
- 5. When kindergarten readiness is confirmed, you will receive an emailed letter of acceptance to CCS.
- 6. Complete the online enrollment process and you're ready for kindergarten!

Kindergarten Prep Options

For students not meeting the basic kindergarten requirements, we offer a KPrep program. Research shows that success or failure in the first years of school can be a major predictor of success or failure in life. This option:

- Provides a valuable transition year prior to kindergarten.
- Builds on prior learning experiences in a more challenging and structured academic environment.
- Gives students time to experience frequent success in a school setting, while developing more self-confidence.
- Offers an enriched program with hands-on opportunities for development in all kindergarten readiness areas.

Many families have discovered that the benefits of Cascade Christian's kindergarten prep experiences extend well beyond elementary years, resulting in a more self-confident and competent adolescent and college-bound student.

What Is the Individual Educational Roadmap?

At Cascade Christian Schools, the Educational Roadmap is like an educational "Google Map" for each of our students.
