A Note on COVID-19 and I-Term Trips

Hello, Cascade Christian Families,

The only thing for certain is that nothing is certain! If the past year has taught us anything, it is to adapt and be flexible. Our heart and desire is to run a "typical" I-Term schedule, complete with both international and domestic trips. However, we understand that much of our world is still in a place of limbo and uncertainty. We are moving forward in promoting our 2023 I-Term trip selections with both the hope that we will be able to run them safely in spring of 2023 and also the peace which comes from knowing that God, in His wisdom, will make the way clear to us. At this point, all of these trips are tentative, and we acknowledge that we may not be able to run a particular trip because of the ever-changing COVID situation.

Starting on Monday, May 23, all HS students were eligible to sign up for trips. Please bring the registration form and your \$100 deposit to the office to sign up. Registration forms must be signed by a parent. Trips outside the Continental US (South Africa, Trinidad and Tobago, Italy/ Greece, and Tokyo) will cap at 20 students. We hope you took the summer to talk, think, and pray as a family as to what trip is the best fit for your student. In this brochure, you will find a payment schedule for each trip.

We understand that families will have varying levels of comfort when it comes to traveling in the coming year. We hope to provide opportunities for all levels of comfort. And please note, **I-Term trips are not required.** We will still offer local I-Term options that will be launched in the fall. Families should dialogue about how they feel if international travel still involves requirements such as COVID testing, mask wearing, vaccines.

We will continue to seek the Lord's guidance and pursue the best and safest options for our students. We look ahead with hope and expectation to all that next year has to offer!

SOUTH AFRICA March 23–April 8, 2023 Approx. \$3,500

TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO March 25–April 3, 2023 Approx. \$2,750



TOKYO, JAPAN March 25–April 3, 2023 Approx. \$3,500

The Lord loves the people of Tokyo. He died for the people of Tokyo, and 99% of them don't even know it. Paul says in Roman 10:13–14, "'Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.' How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard?" Therefore, our goal is to partner with a few local churches to conduct outreach ministry to share the gospel with the youth of Japan. While in Japan, we also plan to visit a Japanese art museum, Tokyo Tower, a mall and shops, and a garden or two. I am agreeing to register my student for the I-Term trip listed above. By signing this form, I acknowledge that the required \$100 trip deposit is nonrefundable. I also understand that I will be expected to stay on top of the payments as listed in the 2023 Payment Schedule. If I decide to pull my student from a trip after payments have been made, I acknowledge that I am NOT guaranteed a refund. I acknowledge that the payment due dates and amounts will be added to my FACTS account, and I agree to have paid the full amount of the trip at least one month prior to the trip taking place.

In order to register your student for a trip, all tuition and student fees need to be current.

Here are the CCS policies that guide our trips:

- 1. For students participating in CCS I-Term trips, all tuition and student fees must be current.
- 2. CCS must have on file a signed trip registration form and \$100 initial deposit. An additional payment of \$250 will be due by September 20, 2022.
- 3. Student's trip accounts must be sufficient to pay for airline ticket before ticket will be purchased.
- 4. Trip balance is due one month before the trip departs. If the balance of the student's trip account is not paid, the student will not be permitted to attend the trip.
- 5. There are NO refunds on trips if you choose to pull your student for personal reasons. If the school is forced to cancel the trip, refunds will be administered as they become available from outside companies. The amounts of refunds are subject to those specific companies and their policies.
- 6. Students must travel to and from their I-Term trips with their teams.
- 7. International students have an additional \$100 fee assessed through our District Office for paperwork related to out-of-country travel.
- 8. I acknowledge that the location in which I choose to travel may have COVID protocols in place to both enter and leave, and by signing up, I am agreeing to be in compliance with those protocols.
