A Note on CCHS I-Term 2026 Trip Registration

Hello, Cascade Christian Families,

I-Term has become one of the incredible programs that make us uniquely Cascade Christian. We understand there is much anticipation surrounding I-Term trip sign-ups, and we are taking steps to ensure this happens fairly and efficiently.

Starting on Tuesday, May 20, all incoming seniors (12th graders in the 2025-26 school year) will be eligible to sign up for trips. Starting on Wednesday May 21, all incoming 11th grade students will be eligible to sign up. And on May 22, registration is officially open to all 10th-12th graders. Please bring the registration form and your \$100 deposit to the office to sign up. Incoming 9th graders will be required to serve locally for their first year in high school. **Registration forms must be signed by a parent.**

***YOU DO NOT NEED TO LINE UP EARLY THIS YEAR. We will collect all forms up until 7:45am. All forms collected before school will be sorted into groups. If you have had suspensions, Saturday schools, or below a 2.0 GPA you will be put into the 2nd group. If we still don't have enough space after sorting the groups, we will go to a lottery. Forms collected after 7:45 am will be dealt with the same way.**

We hope you take time to talk and pray as a family about what trip is the best fit for your student. **In this brochure, you will find a payment schedule for each trip.**

We understand that families will have varying levels of comfort when it comes to traveling in the coming year. We hope to provide opportunities for all levels of comfort. And please note, **I-Term trips are not required**. We will still offer local I-Term options that will be launched in the fall. We will continue to seek the Lord's guidance and pursue the best and safest options for our students. We look ahead with hope and expectation to all that next year has to offer!

SOUTH AFRICA March 19–April 4, 2026 Approx. \$4,000

Students will be working with Living Hope, ministering and doing kids' clubs in the townships of the Western Cape. They will see the gorgeous sights of Cape Town, South Africa. Table Mountain, Lions Head, Cape Point, and Green Market Square will be highlighted. Students will get to stay in a beach house on the shores of beautiful Noordhoek Beach. South Africa has become a staple trip for CCHS I-Term, and this will be the 13th year! Your student will not come home disappointed. NATIONAL PARKS March 21–March 27, 2026 Approx. \$2,400

On the National Parks trip, you will get to explore God's beauty in multiple national parks while serving with A Christian Ministry in the National Parks (ACMNP). ACMNP embodies and extends the ministry of Jesus Christ through worship, witness, and the development of Christian leaders in the national parks. Throughout the week, you will have opportunities to glorify God through hiking, exploring, serving, praying, and worshiping in epic locations. The 2026 National Parks trip will be traveling to the Moab area, visiting Arches, Canyonlands, and Capitol Reef National Parks. **Trip Cap is 22.**



Recife, Brazil March 21–April 4, 2026 Approx. \$3,250

Students will be working with Soli Deo Gloria, an organization set on 60 acres of beautiful Brazilian landscape. Students will be hosting two sports camp (soccer, volleyball, basketball) with local youth, one at Soli Deo Gloria and one out in the community. Students will also be working on campground improvements. They will visit local beaches, attractions, and go to a soccer game. They will be staying 6 days at Soli Deo Gloria and 5 days in a beach house. **Trip Cap is 20.**



Roatan, Honduras March 20–March 30, 2026 Approx. \$2,400

Roatan is a Honduran island in the Caribbean Sea. We will be working with Roatan Mission Fellowship and engaging in a number of service projects, which may include children's education, VBS, outreach to children in need of basic supplies, children's ministry, sports, and construction. Housing and meals will be provided by Roatan Mission Fellowship. **Trip Cap is 20.**

West Bengal, India March 21–March 31, 2026 Approx. \$4000



Children of Promise (CofP), is a child sponsorship organization that invests resources from North American sponsors into the lives of children in 35 countries around the world. The over 4600 sponsored children are guaranteed a) regular nutrition through food delivery or feeding programs, b) education including paid school fees, uniforms, and supplies, c) health care including hygiene items, medical checkups, and as-needed medical care, and d) discipleship through the local congregation. Children of promise programs around the world help to resource and empower local churches to be able to have local children's outreach ministry by way of sponsorship. The people we work with, those extending the daily/weekly/monthly care to the sponsored children are the children's local pastor, worship minister, Sunday school teacher, etc. In this way, it is the local church making wholeness possible through that local ministry. We are a locally shaped, globally supported ministry that seeks to care holistically for children living in poverty in an effort to break the cycle of poverty and write a new story for the children, their families, and their communities. **Trip Cap is 15.**



Bohol, Philippines March 20-March 29th 2026 App. \$2,400

Join us on an unforgettable journey to the beautiful island of Bohol in the southern Philippines, where we will partner with the International Deaf Education Association (IDEA) to serve and connect with hundreds of Deaf students. Our team will engage with four Deaf elementary schools by leading Vacation Bible School-style days that include Gospel-centered conversations, drama, crafts, and field games. At the Bohol Deaf Academy (BDA), IDEA's high school, we'll participate in a Bible study, assist with graduation events, and help with campus clean-up as needed. We'll also worship with the local Deaf community at Tip-Tip Church on Sunday and may host a fellowship meal following the service. In addition to serving, we'll explore some of Bohol's natural wonders, including the world-famous Chocolate Hills, tarsier sanctuaries, a firefly river cruise, and a relaxing beach day. Amsterdam March 21-March 29, 2026 Approx. \$4,000

We will spend eight days in Amsterdam work with CAS Trips, an educational tour company based on the ideas of creativity, activity, and service. Our desire is to engage with the Dutch people, learn and grow as global citizens and leaders, and to represent Jesus well and grow in our understanding of his love for all nations. We will engage in a variety of service and activities including hands on projects working with local residents, bicycle ride in surrounding villages visiting local sites, art museum visit, sustainable fashion project, visiting a local nursing home, cultural immersion challenge, and more. I am agreeing to register my student for the I-Term trip listed above. By signing this form, I acknowledge that the required \$100 trip deposit is **nonrefundable, once I have accepted the roster spot for my student. I also understand that I will be expected to stay on top of the payments as listed in the CCHS I-Term 2026 Trip Payment Schedule.** If I decide to pull my student from a trip after payments have been made, I acknowledge that I am NOT guaranteed a refund. I acknowledge that the payment due dates and amounts will be added to my FACTS account, and I agree to have paid the full amount of the trip at least one month prior to the trip taking place.

Here are the CCS policies that guide our trips:

1. For students participating in CCS I-Term trips, all tuition and student fees must be current.
2. CCS must have on file a signed trip registration form and \$100 initial deposit. An additional payment of \$250 will be due by September 20, 2025.
3. My student's trip account must have sufficient funds to pay for the airline ticket before the ticket will be purchased.
4. The trip balance is due one month before the trip departs. If the balance of my student's trip account is *not* paid, my student will not be permitted to attend the trip.
5. **There are NO refunds on trips if I choose to pull my student for personal reasons.** If the school is forced to cancel the trip, refunds will be administered as they become available from outside companies. The amounts of refunds are subject to those specific companies and their policies.
6. Students must travel to and from their I-Term trips with their teams.
7. International students have an additional \$100 fee assessed through our District Office for paperwork related to out-of-country travel.
