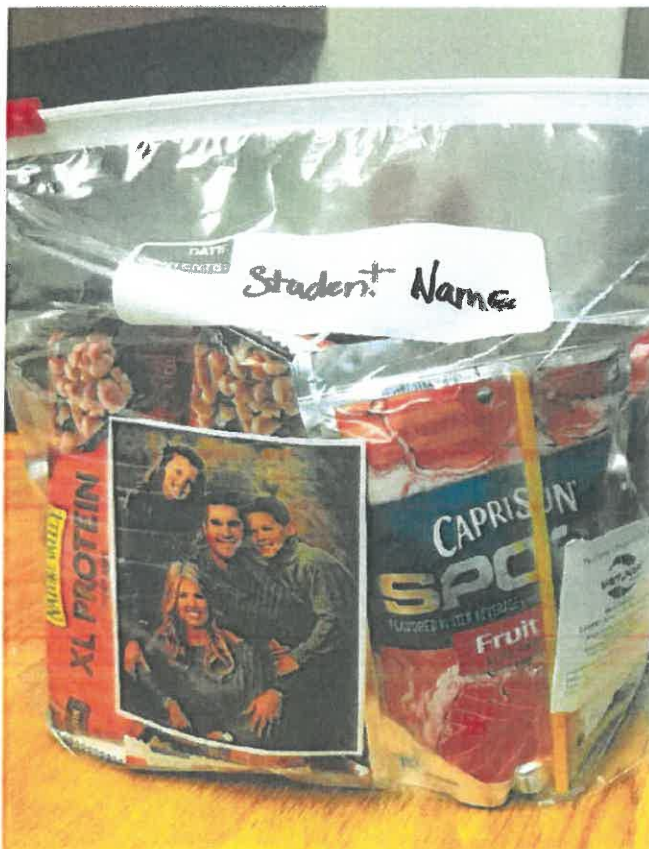

Student Emergency Kit

Kit due Friday, September 9, 2022

Being prepared for emergencies is one of Cascade Christian Schools' top priorities. We have determined that having families provide an emergency kit with items specifically chosen for their K–6 students is better than purchasing kits that quickly become outdated and that students may not want to consume.

Best practice says that each emergency kit should consist of only the following five main items, providing a 3-days' supply of food and water.



Kit Contents:

1. 6 high protein bars (e.g., Nature Valley XL Protein Bars)
2. 6 pouches of plain or flavored water, particularly those high in electrolytes (pouches, such as Capri Sun, fit in the bag better than boxes do)
3. 6 towelettes, such as those found at fast-food restaurants
4. A family photo
5. A slide-zipped gallon-sized bag to hold it all with student's name on it (slide-zipped bags—as shown in the photo below—tend to be easier to use than press-n-seal bags)

Important: Only those items listed in the contents section above should be in the emergency kit. At the end of the school year, the kit will be sent home.
